**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This is the weekly lab for the Math 111 course. Your presence is required at every lab session. You are required to bring a blank copy of that day's assignment to each session. The schedule is available on the course website. During each session the previous week's assignment will be collected, instruction for the next assignment is provided, and a quiz may or may not be administered.

**ATTENDANCE:** You are expected to be in class and on time. You are responsible for all class periods and assignments must be turned in on time. Please contact me if you are aware in advance of an impending absence to make arrangements to turn in your required lab assignment.

**LAB ASSIGNMENTS:** Most lab assignments are due at the start of the lab session, one week after your instruction for that lab. Completed lab assignments will be accepted up to one day late with a 2 point penalty. Any assignments submitted after this time will not be accepted.

**QUIZZES:** Time will be allocated appropriately for quizzes during lab time. Quizzes are assigned at the discretion of the course instructor.

**GRADING:** Each assignment is graded for a maximum of 20 points. You are responsible for completing each lab in its entirety and a part of the grade for each assignment will be set aside for completeness. Proper notation is required throughout the lab and failure to use said notation will result in points being deducted accordingly.

**HONOR CODE:** You are permitted to collaborate with other students on lab assignments unless specifically instructed otherwise. However, your submitted assignment must be your own work and cannot be copied directly from another source. Plagiarism will not be tolerated. See the W&M honor code for further detail.
